

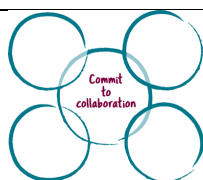
2.2 Assess our need to do this together tool

10.	The situation is stable and predictable 1.....5	It's a moving feast. The situation keeps changing

The 'people' aspect

11.	Don't need anyone else to 'own' the solution 1.....5	High levels of ownership from a wide range of people is essential
12.	This isn't on people's radar 1.....5	There is a lot of interest in this problem and potential solutions
13.	Risk of outrage is low 1.....5	Risk of outrage is high
14.	Don't need lots of people to be involved 1.....5	Diverse views, experiences and knowledge are essential
